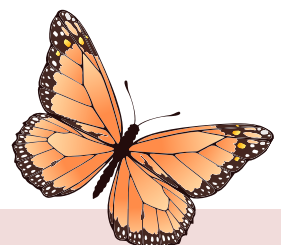

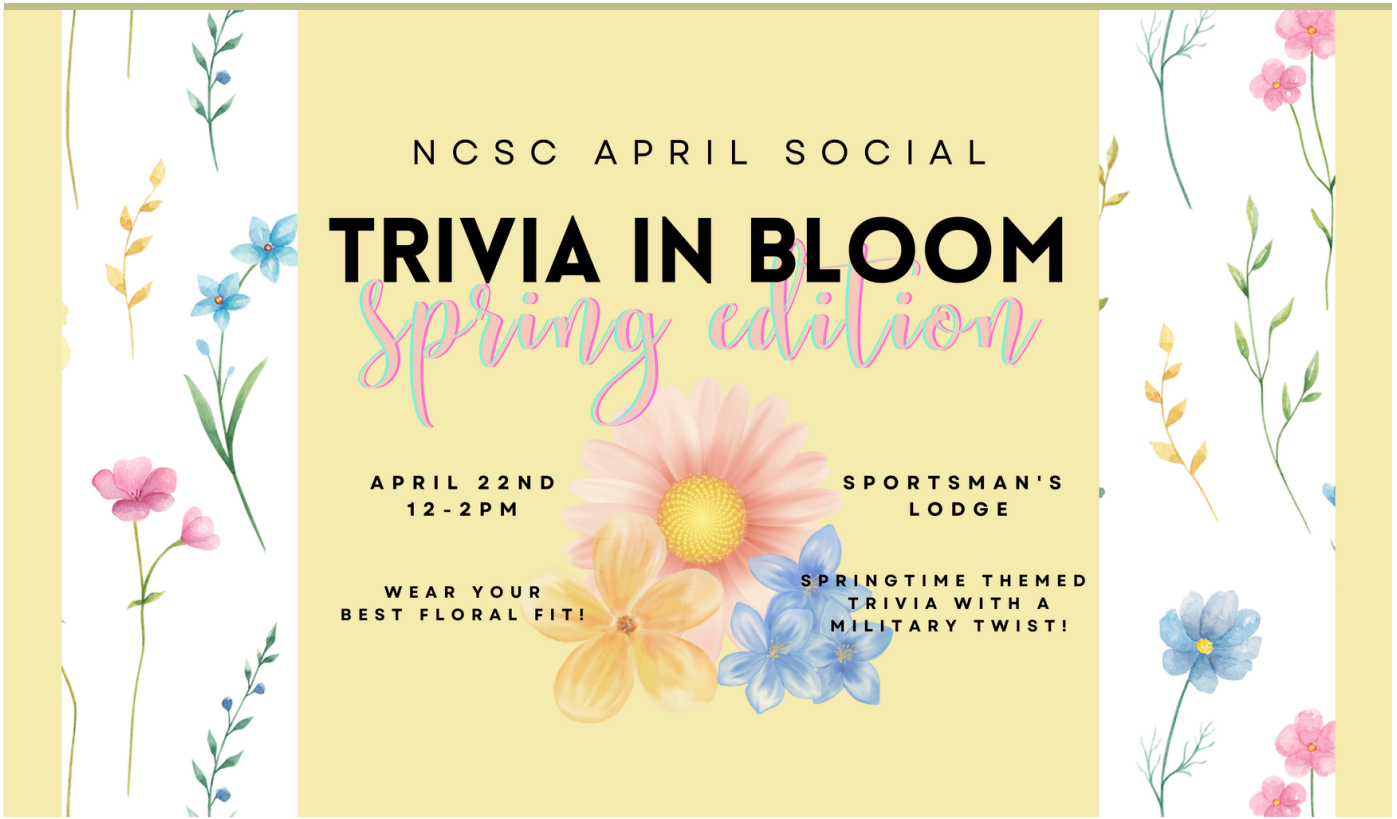

For the month of April NCSC is partnering with **Samaritan Volunteer Services**

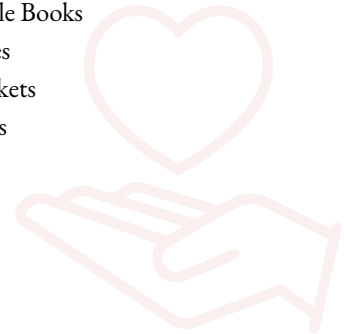
Members who bring in donations to the monthly social will also receive an opportunity ticket.
